BACKGROUND

The AASPA Development Corporation Ltd. (AASPADC) was incorporated under the Anguilla Companies Act, R.S.A. c.C65 and registered with Registration Number 1033781, on 17 September 2019.

The AASPADC was created by its parent entity The Anguilla Air and Sea Ports Authority (AASPA) which is a Government Agency established by section 2 of the Anguilla Air and Sea Ports Authority Act, R.S.A. c. A57 on 26 October 2009.

As part of its mandate, the AASPADC is to help Anguilla realise the Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport (CJLIA) Development to include the extension and upgrade of the runway to at least 8,000 ft effective runway length; upgrade (resurface, strengthening) of existing runway; construction of a new modular terminal facility; additional and new parking for aircraft (airside) and vehicles (landside); including planning, designing, financing, building and operating the Airport, with little or no addition to the AASPA's, GoA's and United Kingdom Government's (UKG's) direct and contingent debt. The developed airport facilities are expected to accommodate and safely receive fully loaded single aisle mid-range aircraft in the Boeing 737-800 and Airbus 320 categories capable of conveying 150 to 189 passengers and long haul aircraft of the B757 and B767 type capable of conveying 200 to 375 passengers from Europe, North and South America.

Interested firms are expected to conduct their own research, scoping and due diligence.

QUALIFICATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

The AASPADC now invites interested eligible firms to submit EOIs for the design, finance, build, operate, transfer of the Clayton J. Lloyd International Airport Development Project - Anguilla

Firms shall be eligible to participate if:

- (a) In the case of a body corporate, it is legally incorporated or otherwise organized in an eligible country, has its principal place of business in an eligible country and is more than 50% beneficially owned by citizen(s) and/or *bona fide* resident(s) of eligible country(ies) or by a body(ies) corporate meeting these requirements;
- (b) In the case of unincorporated firms, the persons are citizens or *bona fide* residents of an eligible country;
- (c) In all cases, the firm has no arrangement and undertakes not to make any arrangements, whereby any substantial part of the net profits or other tangible benefits of the contract will accrue or be paid to a person not a citizen or *bona fide* resident of an eligible country; and
- (d) The firm is not subject to any restrictions under European Council Regulation No.2580/2001 of December 27, 2001 or the Terrorism (United Nations Measures) 2009 of the United Kingdom with a view to combating terrorism.

Eligible countries are member countries of either: Caribbean Development Bank, World Bank, European Development Bank, European Union.

All applicants will be informed as to the status of acceptance of their EOI after the short listing process is completed by December 31, 2019.

The AASPADC reserves the right to accept or reject late applications or to cancel the present invitation partially or in its entirety. The AASPADC will not be bound to assign any reason for not short-listing any applicant and will not defray any costs incurred by any applicant in the preparation and submission of their EOI. This Invitation for EOIs does not represent any contractual agreement or obligation to any respondent.

Only firms with the clear capability to design, finance, build, operate and transfer an airport project of this magnitude need respond to this invitation.

All selected firms will be supplied with more detailed information for their submission of proposals at a future date to be determined. Requests for Proposals to the shortlisted firms are not expected to be issued later than February 1, 2020.
