

Policy Document Stipulating Conditions for Cancellation and Suspension of a Sea Ports Entry Pass

Rationale

Security is of paramount concern at the Sea Ports and therefore persons whose employment require that they access security restricted port areas at the Sea Ports will be subject to a certain level of scrutiny before being issued with Entry Pass passes and while they are the holders of Entry Passes.

Circumstances may occur after the issue of an Entry Pass which requires that consideration be given to cancelling or suspending the Entry Pass previously issued. The conditions for such cancellation or suspension are set out below.

<u>Conditions for cancellation of a Sea Port Entry Pass issued under Section 7(3) of the Sea</u> <u>Ports Regulations</u>

- If the holder of an Entry Pass is convicted of an offence, which can reasonably be viewed as having been facilitated through a breach of security or the circumstances of which involved dishonest or suspicious actions on the part of the holder of the Entry Pass.
- If the authorised sponsor of the Sea Port Entry Pass returns the Entry Pass on behalf of the holder, when there is no longer an operational need or the holder of an Entry Pass has left the authorised sponsor's organisation.
- If the holder of an Entry Pass breaches security and is deemed a risk to Sea Ports operations.
- If the pass holder displays any behavior that may be perceived as a threat or disruption to the port.
- A Sea Port Entry Pass will be cancellation in any other case where it appears reasonable to do so by the Chief Executive Officer of the Anguilla Air & Sea Ports Authority to suspend the Entry Pass.

<u>Conditions for suspension of a Sea Port Entry Pass issued under Section 7(3) of the Sea Ports</u> <u>Regulations</u>

• If the holder of a Sea Port Entry Pass is charged with an offence, which can reasonably be viewed as having been facilitated through a breach of security, or the circumstances of which can reasonably be viewed as involving dishonest or suspicious behaviour on the part

of the holder of the Entry Pass, the Entry Pass will be suspended pending the final determination of the charge.

- If the holder of a Sea Port Entry Pass is suspected of breaching security, the Entry Pass will be suspended immediately pending the outcome of an investigation into the suspected breach of security.
- If the holder of the Sea Port Entry Pass is scheduled to leave the island for a period of time in excess of 30 days the Entry Pass will be suspended.
- A Sea Port Entry Pass will be suspended in any other case where it appears reasonable to do so by the Chief Executive Officer of the Anguilla Air & Sea Ports Authority to suspend the Entry Pass.
